This immersive exhibition presents her provocative film trilogy *And Europe Will Be Stunned*, which chronicles the radical vision of the fictional Jewish Renaissance Movement in Poland. Taking the complexity of Jewish-Polish identity as a point of departure, the films speak to larger themes of nationhood, belonging, and memory.
